We appreciate your patience and flexibility as we balance scheduling and planning with regulations and requirements.

St. Ursula Villa ended our school year on a strong note while creatively reinventing special Villa traditions to align with COVID-19 guidelines. We celebrated a socially distanced May Crowning, honored our Class of 2020 graduates with "drive-in movie"-style ceremonies, and sent families off to summer with teachers waving and lining our "Final Carline" route. It was an unusual year, but our Villa community rose to the challenge and remained connected and supportive. We truly lived our 2019-20 Ursuline school theme, "If you stand united in heart, you will be strong in adversity."

# 2020-21 PLANNING AND COVID-19 TASK FORCE UPDATE

Looking ahead to the 2020-21 school year, we hope that on August 19<sup>th</sup> we will reopen with our strong teachers delivering in-person learning to all our Villa students in classrooms. We will also be prepared for alternatives as needed. St. Ursula Villa's administration and Board of Trustees has formed a COVID Task Force to help guide our decision-making over the next several months and will regularly meet to develop three plans for next year given the current guidelines and scenarios. #### **2020-21 TUITION PAYMENT PLANS**

We are researching using a Tuition Management Service to streamline billing. As a result, we have not yet sent our usual tuition payment plans with a June billing timeframe. The new billing system will likely structure monthly payment plans beginning in August or September. We will keep you informed when the decision is final and send the appropriate paperwork.

### **SUMMER CAMP**

We are redesigning our Villa Summer Camp programming to accommodate safety guidelines and recommended limitations.
